# **B. TECHNICAL PROVISIONS**

The competition is run according to rules given by the organizer in compliance with the military manual of the Czech Armed Forces Vševojsk 4-2 "Instructions on shooting handguns and combat vehicles weapons" with partly modified exercise rules and in compliance with the "General Rules of Sports Shooting" and "Technical Rules of the Army Reserve Association of the Czech Republic" pursuant to the rules given by other military provisions.

# 1. EVENTS AND SPECIFICATIONS



The shooting must by started NLT 10 second after signal "FIRE!" – in case of a later start of shooting, the competitor will be disqualified.

When changing the targhet from Number 1 to Number 2, it is necessary to reload the weapon with a second magazine with ten rounds.

Each competitor has his/her own target and assigned gun for standing positions in one event. The team members are shooting simultaneously within a given time **without using the binoculars, optics and other non-standard accessories**. After the sighting and after finishing the event, the competitors will be allowed to check the rersults achived by the presence of the Fire Director or the Target Support Personnel.

## 2. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Competitors who are not Czech MoD/Armed Forces personnel are obliged to secure health or accident insurance individually. During the Competition medical service will be provided by the Czech Armed Forces medical service.

All competition participants are obliged to follow instructions by Competition Officials throughout the Competition.

#### 3. EVALUATION

Evaluation of the Competition is to be in two categories:

- Category No1. soldier, reservists, members of emergency services, allied countries and guests invited by RMC
- Category No2. for age category 60+

All results will be provided by evaluating committee NLT 30 minutes after end of the shooting competition.

The announcement of result will be presented at the final award ceremony.

#### 1.1. Teams – overall placing:

#### Category No1.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Challenge Cup of The Mayor of Jablonec nad Nisou town, gift for each team's member, cup and certificate
- 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> place gift for each team's member, cup and certificate

## Category No2.

■ 1<sup>st</sup> – Challenge Cup of General Karel MRÁZEK, gift for each team's member, cup and certificate

■ 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> place – gift for each team's member, cup and certificate

The best female shooter – gift, cup and certificate
The best foreign shooter – gift, cup and certificate
The absolute winner – gift cup and certificate

Please take in your cosideration, the winner team of the Challenge Cup, is obliged to bake cup return to organizer NLT 30JUN2026. The cups are traveling and are loaned to winning team for one year.

Placing of teams shall be determined by the total score all team members gained in the events.

- 1. In case the total score of two (and more) teams is equal → higher quantity of scored 10s, 9s, 8s (...) prevails.
- 2. If there is no decision, a higher score in the event → result of member of team with the lowest score will be placed in a lower position or the farthest shot of the member with the lowest score.

#### 4. PROTESTS:

Protests may be submitted to the Competition Director during the course of the Competition 10 minutes after results publishing only. The jury shall decide whether the protest is justified. Decisions made by the jury are binding for all the competitors.

Everyone can be submitted protest if they pay a handling fee of 700 CZK. In the case of non-recognition th protest the contribution 700 CZK is forteited in favor of the organizer.

#### 5. WEAPONS/AMMUNITION:

Shooting guns introduced in the inventory of the Czech Armed Force. The organizer provides both weapons and ammunition for the Competition; the use of own weapons and ammunition is forbidden.

## **C. ORGANIZATIONAL ARRANGEMENTS**

All competition participants are obliged to follow instructions by Competition Officials throughout the Competition.

# F. APPENDIX

# **SAFETY RULES:**

All shooters are obliged to follow the instructions by the Fire Directors of the sites, with an emphasis on safe operating of the weapons and observance of the Safety Rules. Weapons are to be handled only on the Fire Director's order; the gun is to be pointed into the designated firing sector only. It is prohibited to point the gun rearward or off the firing sector.

If there is a gun failure and the shooter is not able to fix it within the time allowed for firing, he/she raises a hand to notify the Fire Director who will then take necessary measures.

While shooting, all shooters are required to use ear protection gear and protective glasses. It is strictly forbidden to consume alcoholic beverages, chemical substances affecting concentration or any

other addictive substances throughout the competition, as defined in the Range Operating Procedures.

All competitors are required to comply with a random Breathalyzer test if asked. Noncompliance can lead to disqualification.

The organizer shall not be held responsible for any damage to the participant's personal belongings or injury.

The shooter is expected to be ready to proceedapproximately 15 second after the "Load and Make Ready" ("NABÍJET!") command

The shooter is ready. The command "FIRE" ("PÁLIT!") will be followed by the start signal within 1-4 second. The shooter may not move or change position.

The command "STOP FIRE" ("Palbu ZASTAVIT!") is given when something unsafe has happened or is about to happen during a stage, or when somethingin the stage is not correct. The shooter must immediately stop all movement, place the trigger finger obviously and visibly outside the triggerguard, andawait further instruction.

The command "FINISHED, UNLOAD AND SHOW CLEAR" ("Palbu ZASTAVIT - náboj SKRYJ!") will be issued when the shooter has apparently finished shooting the stage. If the shooter is finished, all ammunition will be removed from the firearm and an empty magazine and a clear chamber/cylinder will be shown to the SO. Once the SO has inspect the magazine and chamber/cylinder and found it to be clear, this command will be issued and the shooter will comply.

Should the competitor break the Safety Rules, he/she will be disqualified.
